Heisler went on to share details of a significant development in New York pertaining to the future direction of the OWS movement. He detailed specifics of how OWS dealt with growth, new occupiers, and other issues at Occupy Wall Street's capital in New York's Zucotti Park. Heisler said the explosion of occupy groups worldwide has taken OWS by surprise, but there is an effort to catch up and "centrally connect OWS entities worldwide" in order to harness the phenomena that is occurring. Heisler traveled to Los Angeles to coordinate with Occupy LA Media. He hopes to help organize a vast cloud database of media resources worldwide to ensure the movement's message is clear, direct and used effectively. Heisler's excitement in his visit to Los Angeles indicated that he and the movement are aware of the constant need for one more voice in media. Occupy Wall Street plans to cloud-connect every occupation into a global chorus of power – so get ready.
